




STRUMMING THE NYLON STRUNG GUITAR

Throughout this book, you will find many references to the use of a pick with the right hand. Although you may use a pick with nylon strings, it is not necessary and, instead, the lare thumb or finger may be used directly across the strings. As you become more adept and use more advanced methods, you will soon laam the various fams of strums and plucking finger style that are unique to folk style playing.

LEFT HAND-SIDE VIEW




If you stand while playing, the use of a neck cord is advisable.

GENERAL RULE: Thumb plays the bass strings 6, 5, 4. Third finger 1st string, Second finger 2nd string and the First finger 3rd string.


Basic thumb stroke is best for the beginner, Brush the thumb downward over the strings to be played.

HOW TO TUNE THE SPANISH GUITAR

The open strings of the Sponish Guitar when correctly tured, sound she tones, E. A. D. G. B. E from the 6th to 1st string, it is important to somewher in huring that the 6th string is nearest you when the instrument is hold in playing position.


TUNING FROM THE PIANO KEYBOARD

The piono keyboard affords the easiest method for tuning your instrument quickly and correctly. The following diagrammatic illustration shows the location and relationship of the apen strings to the keyboard. Middle "C" is indicated as the keyboard chart for orientation purposes only. First locals this key on the planeforte, lit is the white key, to the left the group of two black keys, in the center of the keyboard directly under the manufacturers name), then test the open strings E. A. D. G. B. E. in the manuar shows below.



TUNING FROM A SPANISH GUITAR TUNER

When a plana is not evailable, the guilar tener will be forced a valuable aid to the beginner in fearning to tune. It consists of Six Blow Pipes Pitched 5-A-D-G-B and 5, to which the six strings of the guilar may be sured. Be sure to tune the strings on address fower than the tones produced by the tuner.



TUNING WITHOUT AID OF PIANO OR TUNER

Twee the E or 6th string as low as will produce a good tane. Then place the finger directly behind the 5th Fret of the 6th String and twee the open 5th String in Unition. Then place the linger directly behind the 5th Fret of the 5th String and tune the open 4th String in Veiton. Then place the finger directly behind 5th Fret of the 4th String and twee the open 3rd String in Unition. Then place the finger directly behind the 4th Fret of the 3rd String and tune the open 2nd String in Unition. Then place the tinger directly behind the 5th Fret of the 2nd String and tune the open 1st String in Unition.

THE DIAGRAMMATIC SYSTEM

THE LEFT-HAND FINGERS



The chart is a simulated fingerboard. The vertical (down) lines represent the strings, and the horizontal lacrossl lines the metal frets. The black dats . indicate the left hand finger placements. The ciphers 0 above the chart, indicate straines 6 5 4 3 the string is not fingered but is played "open" in the chord. The numerals 1, 2, 3, 4 designate the left hand fingers to be employed.

CARE OF THE GUITAR

- Do not tune the guitar above or below pitch. Tuning it too high may cause the bridge to come off and it may cause top damage. Tuning it too law will cause "buzzing" or rattling when you play.
- 2. De not use metal strings on a nylon-classic quitar.
- Rusty strings dull tane. Worn out strings lose their brilliance. Replace your strings regularly.
- 4. Avoid storing the guitar in below 30% humidity conditions as this is the prime cause of cracking.
- 5. Avaid prolonged high humidity conditions as this is the prime cause of warpage,
- Use a humidifier in your guitar case as this retains a certain amount of moisture leside and helps dater cracking.
- Neck warpage is the cause of most string height problems. When not using
 the guitar for a few weeks or more, leasen the strings of least ½ tone.
- 8. It is more difficult to play a guitar when the strings are too high off the fingerboard. If the top of the guttar has "bellied" up, raising the bridge and the strings, have the bridge lowered to offset this. If neck warpage causes high action, have the nock reserviced.
- Never store a guitar in the trunk of an automobile or in a closer for any length of time.
- Keep your instrument clean. Use a polish that is not oily. (We recommend Goya Guitar Polish).
- Use a light grade of sewing machine oil on the gears of your machines, both for lubrication and as a rust preventative.
- 12. Keep your guitar under constant service and maintenance. Repair oil cracks, warps or any damage so that it will always be in good playing condition, enabling you to obtain the fullest enjoyment from your guitar.

HOW TO STRING THE NYLON GUITAR



The p knot in the end of the string and slip through the hele in the bridge.

(a) Loop the and back and under the string (b) then across the top of the bridge and under the string.

(c) Pull to tighten (d) making sure that the point of pressure of the string against itself is on the back bottom side (see arrow in D).
